# Anti Ragging / Discipline Rules

#### **ANTI RAGGING/DISCIPLINE RULES**

In order to have Zero tolerance to ragging and its total elimination from the educational institutions, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its orders dated 4\* May, 2001, 16" May, 2007 and 11" Feb. 2009 has directed as hereunder.

- 1. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the institution.
- 2. Anyone indulging in ragging is liable to be punished appropriately. Punishment shall be Exemplary and justifiable harsh.
  - 3. Punishment for ragging includes:
    - i) Imprisonment/fine or both.
- ii) Expulsion from the institution, Suspension from the institution or classes for

a limited period and fine with a public apology.

- iii) Withholding scholarships or other benefits. iv) Debarring from representation in events.
  - v) Withholding of results.
  - vi) Suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess and the like.
- 4. If the individuals committing or abetting ragging are not identified, collective punishment shall be resorted to.
- 5. Character/migration certificate(s) issued by the institution shall have an entry apart from that of general conduct and behavior to the effect whether the student had participated in particular was published for ragging.
- 6. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging/indiscipline in the past or if it is noticed later that he has indulged in ragging, admission shall be refused to him/her or he/she shall be expelled from the institution forthwith.

- 1. Attested copies of the certificates of Matriculation or its equivalent examination and plus Two (10+2) or its equivalent examination with the conversion formula of grade into percentage wherever applicable with relevant testimonials.
- 2. Proof of the Date of Birth (if not given in the matriculation Certificate, Attested Photocopies of supporting documents)
- 3. In case of NRI's/NRI sponsored candidate & the Foreign National the following additional documents are also required:
- i) Proof of Nationality in the case of Foreign Nationals.
- ii) Sponsorship documents in case of NRI/NRI sponsored candidates.
- iii) Proof of their status in case of NRI's/NRI sponsored candidate & the Foreign Nationals—the following shall be considered as a proper proof:
- (a) Copy of the Non resident Card/Employment card issued by the employer.
- (b) Photocopy of the immigration card/employment Visa, entry on the passport along with details of the passport.
- (c) Certificate issued by the Indian Embassy/High Commission.
- (d) Photocopy of the latest assessment order of income Tax Authorities either in India or the country of employment filled in the status of NRI.
- iv) Certificate of sponsorship from an NRI in case of a sponsored candidate along with proof of NRI status of the sponsorship as required above.

The admission to BCA/BBA course will be made on the basis of merit of the qualifying examination. As per H.P. University rules, 75% seats will be filled out of the candidates who have passed their 10+2 examination from the school situated in Himachal Pradesh irrespective of the Board. Remaining 25% seats will be filled on all India basis and reservation rules of H.P. University/H.P. Govt. shall be applicable. Admission to the course except for seats reserved for NRI's/NRI sponsored and foreign students shall be subject to the following conditions:

- A) 15% and 7.5% seats shall be reserved for schedule caste/scheduled tribe candidates respectively, who have passed their qualifying examination from H.P. Board of School Education or any other school affiliated to CBSE, ICSE etc. within territorial jurisdiction of H.P.
- B) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for outstanding sports persons.
- C) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for outstanding cultural activists.
- D) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for physically handicapped candidates.
- E) One seat will be reserved for a single girl child in BBA and BCA respectively.






